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The authors regret that throughout our recently published article we adopted the nomenclature allogenic cranioplasty to indicate the use of synthetic calvarial implants. As is pointed out to us by the attentive reader, this is incorrect. In cranioplasty literature the terms “allogenic”

and “alloplastic” are often used interchangeably, incorrectly. In our text we are referring to artificial materials of non-human origin and should have therefore applied the nomenclature “alloplastic”.
